Let's do it together!

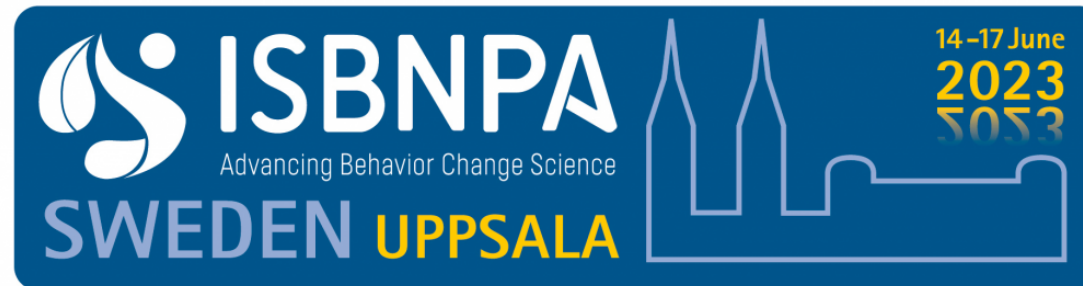
