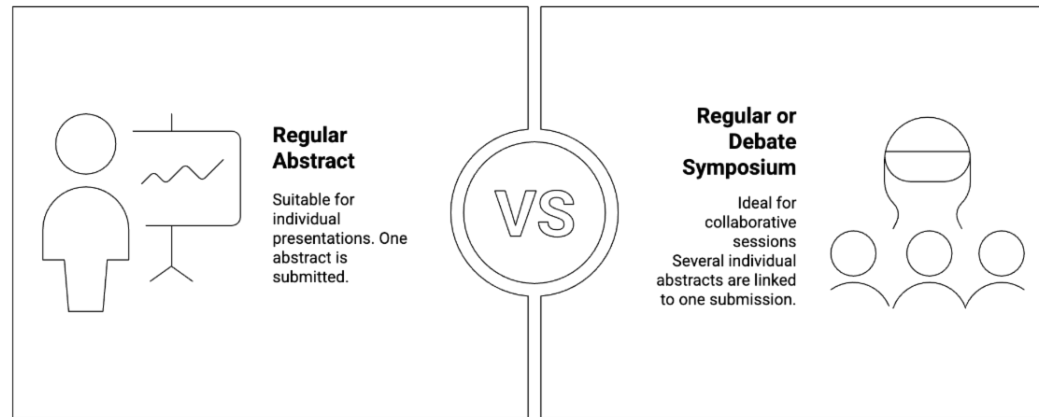

First, decide the submission format

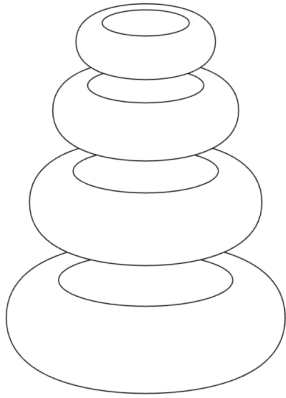


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Regular abstract

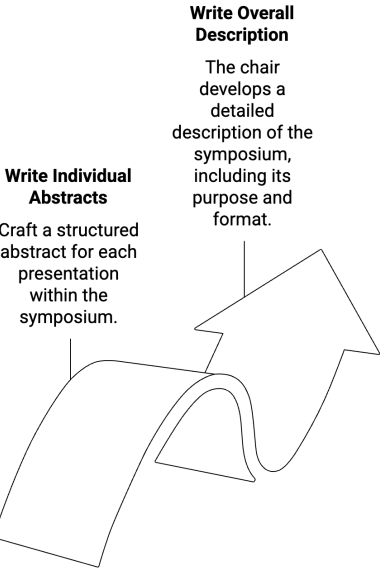

Regular Symposium or Debate Symposium

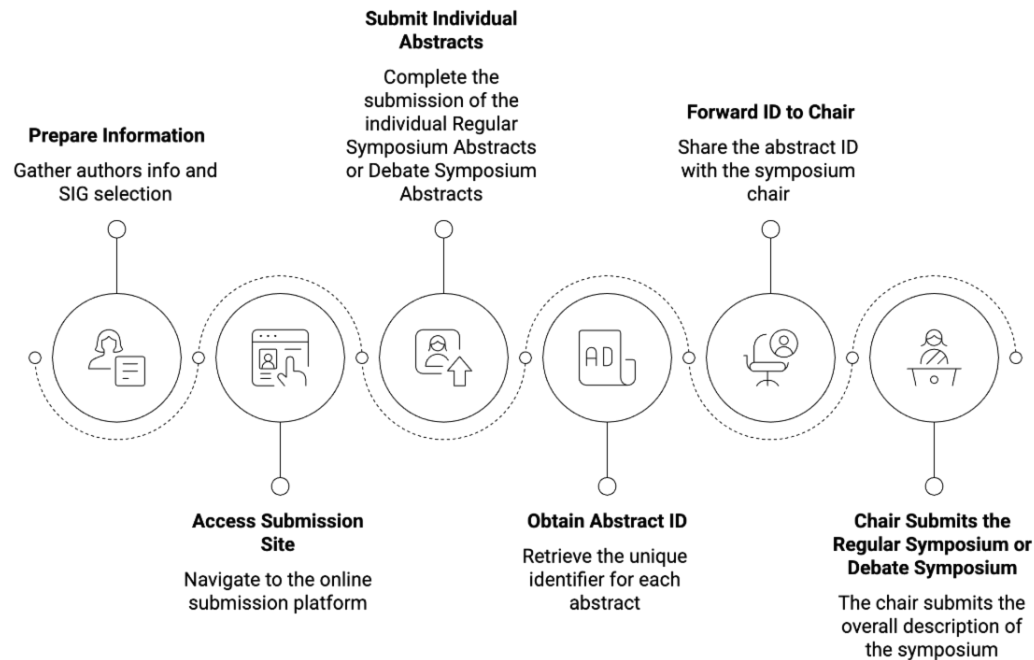
You and your colleagues will be submitting a joint session around a common topic. Several abstracts are submitted. A bit more "abstract", with a few steps.
