

First, decide the submission format



You will be submitting for an oral, short-oral, or poster presentation at the conference. This one is easy (not very "abstract"...).

Regular Abstract Submission



Regular Symposium or Debate Symposium

You and your colleagues will be submitting a joint session around a common topic. Several abstracts are submitted.

A bit more "abstract", with a few steps.

Second, prepare your symposium submission

Write Overall Description

The chair develops a detailed description of the symposium, including its

purpose and format.

Write Individual Abstracts

Craft a structured abstract for each presentation within the symposium.
